

Jesus walks on water

Here are some activities you could try to help your child explore the story of Jesus walking on water.



Read or listen to the story. You can always retell the story at bath time or with some blue material.



Sing some songs about water, like Row row row your boat.



During snack time, have some melon and talk about how God is always with us.



Find out what floats and sinks during bath time or use a bowl of water.



Try some water walking. Get your feet wet and then make some water footprints.



Brush or finger paint a picture of the sea. You could then add a boat if you want.



Squirt shaving foam on a tray and add blue glitter. Add some figures and boats to play in.

Try making some footprints in different materials like mud, sand or even paint.



Make a boat using a cardboard box. You could decorate the boat and add a sail.
